

Worship Leader

The position of Worship Leader will be primarily to oversee music and musicians for the Cornerstone worship service.

In the interest of maintaining consistency and comfortability for the worshippers, staff, and volunteers, the Worship Leader should be able to understand the current processes for presentation of music and leadership of volunteer musicians and be willing to facilitate as such.

The primary role of the Worship leader is to be a Disciple of Jesus Christ. As this position is representative of the church, it is expected that the worship leader will lead a life empowered by the Holy Spirit, and by God's grace offered through Jesus Christ.

The technical role of the Worship leader is to be the "Lead Worshipper". This moniker is one for the entire team, but specifically to this position. Giving direction to the congregation, offering prayer, and managing the flow of the music portion of worship will be the responsibility of the worship leader. Managing flow includes transitions between songs, attention to time, and helping to avoid long pauses or gaps in moving between worship elements.

The musicians and volunteers are a talented group, and have become very comfortable with the current situation. It will be most effective and helpful to encourage and allow them to operate within their current skill set. Encouraging strong musicianship and performance is greatly beneficial. Setting tempo and drawing the band into group playing is a necessary function of worship leader.

Job duties

- Lead worship service and worship team
- Select music for services
- Organize music, create new charts, and maintain music catalogue
- Meet with Pastor to determine music selection/theme
- Create slides/presentation
- Maintain equipment (audio, video, computer, instruments)
- Oversee volunteer A/V team (both services)
- Facilitate rehearsals
- Other duties as assigned
